## Frequenty asked questions

## FAQs for Activity 1

#### Can the Ukrainian scientist apply directly to Activity 1?

No. The grant must be applied for, paid to, and administered by the Australian organisation. The Australian organisation will be responsible for facilitating payments to the visiting Ukrainian researchers as per the executed funding agreement.

#### Who is considered a beneficiary?

A beneficiary is seen as the Ukrainian citizen or Ukrainian permanent resident who is benefitting from the grant. In Activity 1, that is the visiting Ukrainian researcher, and for Activity 2, it is the applying Ukrainian researcher.

## Can a beneficiary be awarded a grant from Activity 2 if they are also a visiting researcher under Activity 1?

No. A visiting researcher under Activity 1 is not able to receive a grant under Activity 2, even if it is for a different project.

# If the application is for a conference, does each visiting researcher need a separate application?

No. If the visiting researchers are attending the same conference and site visit program, and the grant is being applied for and administered by one Australian host organisation, the application can be for multiple visiting researchers.

# If the application is for a research project, does each visiting researcher need a separate application?

No. If the visiting researchers are being hosted by a single Australian host organisation, and working on the same project, they can be included in a single application.

## FAQs for Activity 2

#### Can I apply to access a facility that's not part of the NCRIS group?

No, this round will only provide funding for facilities that are part of the NCRIS group. If you have questions about the facilities covered in Activity 2, please email <a href="mailto:grants@science.org.au">grants@science.org.au</a>.

#### Who is considered a beneficiary?

A beneficiary is seen as the Ukrainian citizen or Ukrainian permanent resident who is benefitting from the grant. In Activity 1, that is the visiting Ukrainian researcher, and for Activity 2, it is the applying Ukrainian researcher.

### Can a Ukrainian institute receive multiple grants under Activity 2?

Yes. Each grant must be for a separate project and be submitted on an individual application. A Ukrainian institute is **not** considered a beneficiary.

## Can a Ukrainian researcher receive more than one grant under Activity 2 for separate projects?

No. Each beneficiary can only receive one grant under the program from either Activity 1 or Activity 2, but not both.
